IT'S NOT SURPRISING

that well-known professional numismatist Steven L. Contursi approaches his work with acute precision and has tremendous delight in new discoveries. Afterall, he studied to be a scientist.

Contursi, a native of New York who began collecting as a youngster, began working part-time for a coin dealer while perusing a graduate degree in physics at the University of

Minnesota in 1975. He subsequently worked at several dealerships before founding Rare Coin Wholesalers (www.RareCoinWholesalers.com) in 1991 where he



This led to a resounding consensus of the experts who proclaimed it as the first silver dollar struck by the young United States, a story that made national headlines.

Contursi publicly displayed the coin in a custom-made, four-foot-tall wooden exhibit case in a dozen cities around the country and at the American Numismatic Association's (ANA) headquarters museum. Tens of thousands of people saw it in person.

"This is a national treasure," said Contursi. "I never wanted to simply hide it in a vault because this coin is to our economy and international trade what the Declaration of Independence was to

"This deep and dark wine shows stunning concentration, a smooth structure and subtle complexities that will expand and evolve over time. Saturated with blueberry, dark chocolate, cocoa and spearmint notes that are firmly wrapped in muscular tannins. Becomes sleeker and more ethereal as it opens up in the glass. The grapes come from two parts of the famous vineyard, one on the more elevated, foothills side and the other on flatter land near Highway 29. Aged in 70% new oak. Drinkable now, but best from 2029."

1776 Continental Currency

Certified by the Professional Coin Grading Service as Mint State 63





The 1776 Continental Dollar is one of the most popular coins of the colonial era. It was stamped with the date 1776, when American patriotism was extremely high and the Declaration of Independence was signed. On the reverse of the coin, the thirteen original colonies are linked together with "American Congress" and "We Are One" stamped in the middle. The coin is believed to be made by Elisha Gallaudet for the Continental Congress and was made out of pewter as the United States was not able to secure a loan of silver from the French at that time.
